Collin Wants to Be a Doctor

"I want to be a doctor one day," declares Collin. Right now he is a 5th grade student at Lavanneau, a CCH partner school. Collin is a regular kid: hardworking, loves to learn, loves to play soccer and dreams of becoming a doctor to help his community.



Several times per year, the CCH Mobile Clinic drives to the mountains of Lavanneau and provides medical care for students at Collin's school. This is Collin's only opportunity to see a doctor or get medicine.

In October 2020 Collin came to the clinic feeling sick - headache, stomachache, fever and the chills. He made a 30 minute walk down the mountain from his small home to the clinic, knowing he needed help, "When I am sick, I never go to see a doctor, because my parents don't have money. There's no clinic or hospital in my community," says Collin.


