Dear CCH Supporters,

We are thankful to those of you who have reached out asking how you can best support our staff and partners in Haiti right now. Given the plethora of articles, analyses and op-eds in the news, many of you have also asked thoughtful questions about how aid funding is directed and distributed in Haiti. *Is it safe to donate to Haiti and Haitian ministries right now - especially with everything that's happening? Is CCH able to get the funds to Haiti? Are the funds making it to their intended beneficiaries?* You are right to ask questions, and we are grateful for your concern.

When you donate to CCH, 100% of your donation supports CCH's work equipping and empowering Haitians. Approximately 87-cents of every dollar donated to CCH supports our programs in Haiti - things like our medical clinics, our school partnerships, our training programs and our hands-on work in and with rural communities. The other 13-cents of every dollar donated supports additional activities here in the US that directly impact those programs - things like our communications (which keep you updated), our fundraising (which leverages your dollars) and our administrative work (which keeps us organized, strategic and accountable as we steward your gifts for greatest impact). When you give to CCH, you're treating sick patients; you're training teachers and improving schools; you're helping Haitian men and women support their families - now and in the future.

We have secure and reliable pathways for transferring funds from the US to Haiti. Our Haiti leadership are able to access those funds to support our day-to-day work and provide regular reporting on how funds are being spent. CCH's financial records are audited annually in compliance with nonprofit best practices, and we're proud of our [Guidestar gold rating](#).

To be clear: CCH does not send funding to or through the Government of Haiti and is in no way affiliated with political groups, parties or candidates. Our mission is to transform lives, one by one, through long term and community driven solutions in healthcare, education and community development.
