CCH partner schools are bursting at the seams. Many families displaced by gang violence in other parts of Haiti are relocating to Jacmel, and our schools have a great reputation thanks to our donors' investment in teacher training, hot lunches, and school nurses.

In the first half of 2025, CCH hosted 2 teacher training events, mobile health check ups and vaccine clinics for several partner schools. We also began supplementing our lunches with "iron fish" during the cooking process to combat anemia. Our school nurses were trained in pain management and mental health practices along with our clinic staff. Three CCH staff members were trained in a new *Men Who Know* curriculum, which complements our *Days for Girls* program in human growth and development. Boys and girls received this age-appropriate training during the spring semester and summer camp participants will hear an abridged version of the training in July.
