



Healthcare Impact Report

CCH's Primary Care Clinic kicked off our long-awaited vaccine program in January 2025. This is a partnership between the Haitian Ministry of Health (MSPP) and CCH, where MSPP provides the vaccines, and CCH administers them to patients. So far this year, over 400 children and adults have received vaccines at our clinic and CCH mobile clinics at our partner schools.

Our PT/OT Rehab Clinic is treating 48% more patients than last year. Word continues to spread about the specialized and compassionate care we offer, which is increasingly difficult to find in Haiti. Our Rehab Clinic received a small shipment of donated equipment and supplies in March, and a larger shipment of donated PT/OT equipment is scheduled to arrive in July. This equipment will allow our busy staff to serve and help even more patients.

Mental health is another key focus for CCH this year. In partnership with Jacmel nonprofit Sous Lavi, CCH offered our healthcare staff training in how to deal with trauma and life balance.
